

THE JACKSON-VINTON FARM BUREAU SCHOLARSHIP FUND

The Jackson-Vinton Scholarship Fund was established by the Jackson-Vinton Board of Trustees in 1997. The objective of the scholarship fund is to assist students, with special preference given to Agriculture related study. If the Agriculture requirement is not met, the scholarship then opens up to other fields of study.

(2) SCHOLARSHIPS -- AMOUNT: \$500 EACH

QUALIFICATIONS OF APPLICANTS

1. Applicant must be enrolled as a full-time student in either a two-year or four-year college or university program; or enrolling as a Freshman full-time student this Fall.
2. (1) Scholarship will be awarded to a full-time student enrolling as a Freshman;
(1) Scholarship will be awarded to either a Junior or Senior, or a student in 2nd year of a Two year program.
3. Scholarship monies will be paid to the educational institution and recipient.
4. There shall be no barrier to apply because of sex, race, color, creed, handicap, or other non-merit factor.
5. In case of a potential conflict of interest involving a member of the Selection Committee, the member shall resign and shall be replaced by another non-involved person.
6. Attach an official transcript of grades from your most recent year of education.

SELECTION

Selection of the final applicant(s) will be made by a Scholarship Selection Committee. Personal interviews of the final candidates may be requested by the Committee.
