

Scholarships for Prospective Mathematics and Science Teachers

Juniors, seniors and graduate students wishing to become mathematics or science educators may be eligible to receive a Noyce scholarship for up to \$17,000 per academic year for two years. These scholarships can be used at Ohio University, Shawnee State University, or the University of Rio Grande.

Noyce scholar recipients must be seeking a teaching license in science and or mathematics with plans to teach in a middle or high school district in Appalachia Ohio. Special consideration will be given to first generation college students that are residents of an Ohio Appalachian county. Students seeking a teaching license in Physical Science are strongly encouraged to apply

Scholarships applications for the 2009-2010 academic year are now being accepted.

Scholarship Application reviews will begin April 30, 2009.

The Noyce Scholarship program is sponsored by the *National Science Foundation* and is administered by the *South East Ohio Center for Excellence in Mathematics and Science* (SEOCEMS).
