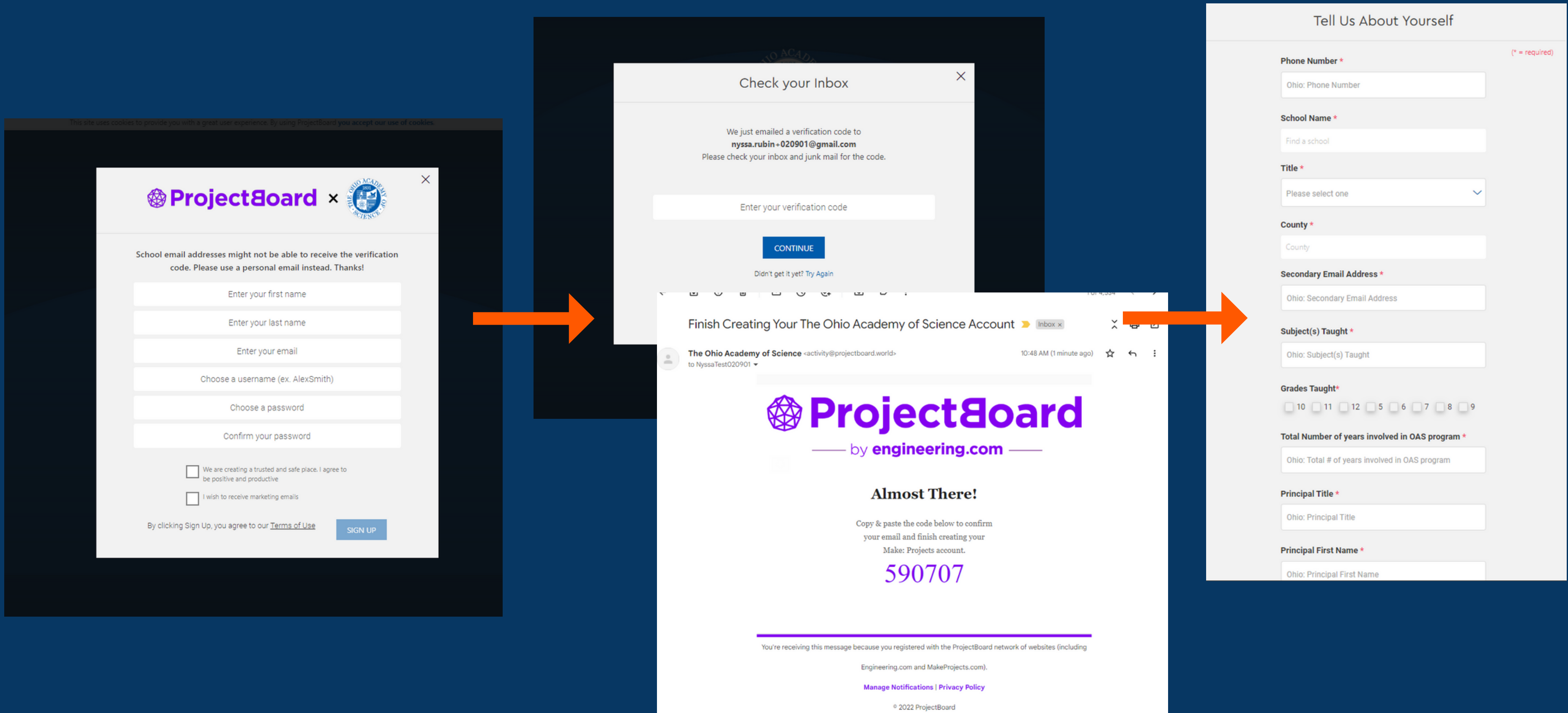
Here, you can participant in [our programs](#) using ProjectBoard, the tool to create, develop and showcase projects online.

Complete the registration forms. You will receive a verification code in your email. Make sure to check your spam, or try resending if you cannot find the email.



Upon successful registration, you will be prompted to start your new class. You can do this now or later (to do it later, hit CANCEL).

Give your class a name and add a photo (from your files or our stock images). You will see your **class code**.

The **class code** is what your students will need to register for your class. You can copy this number now or later.

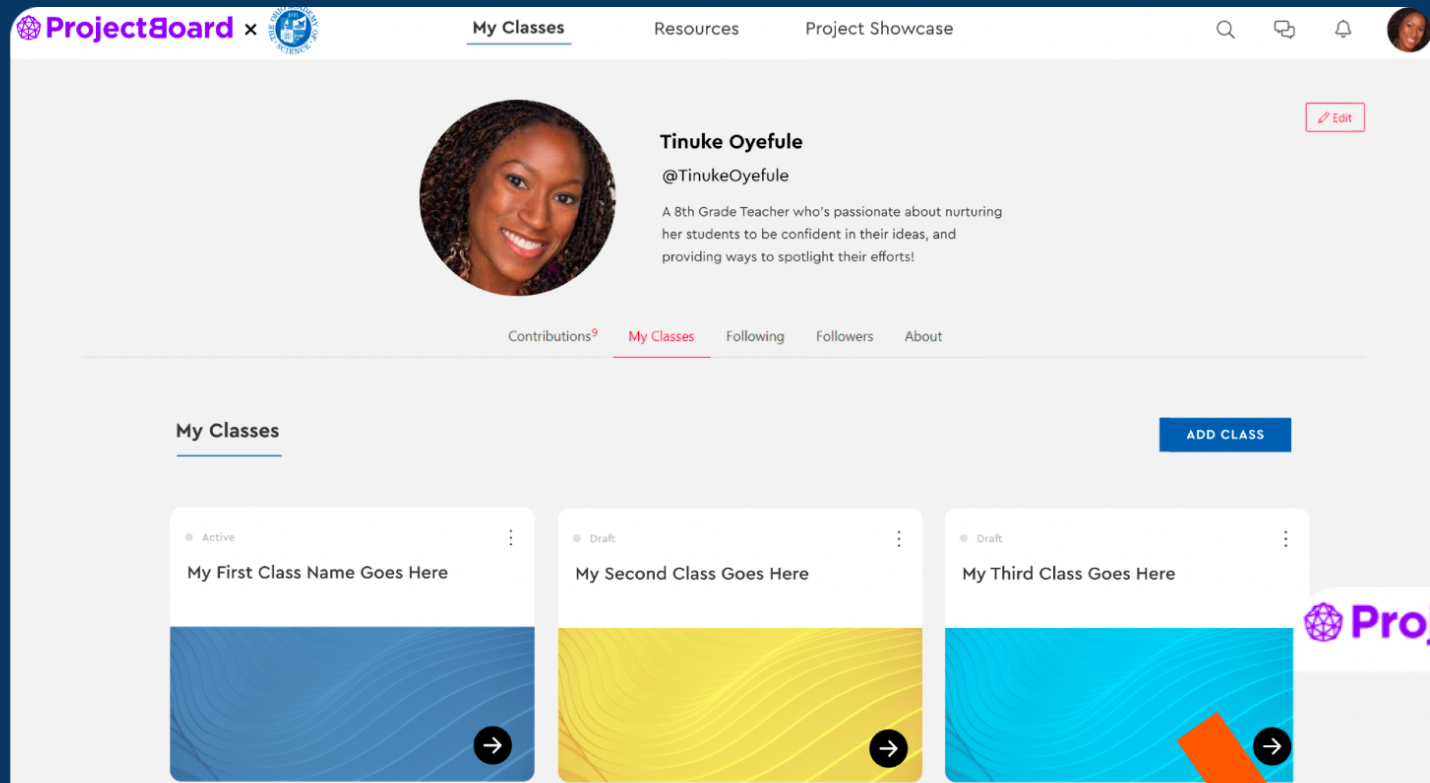

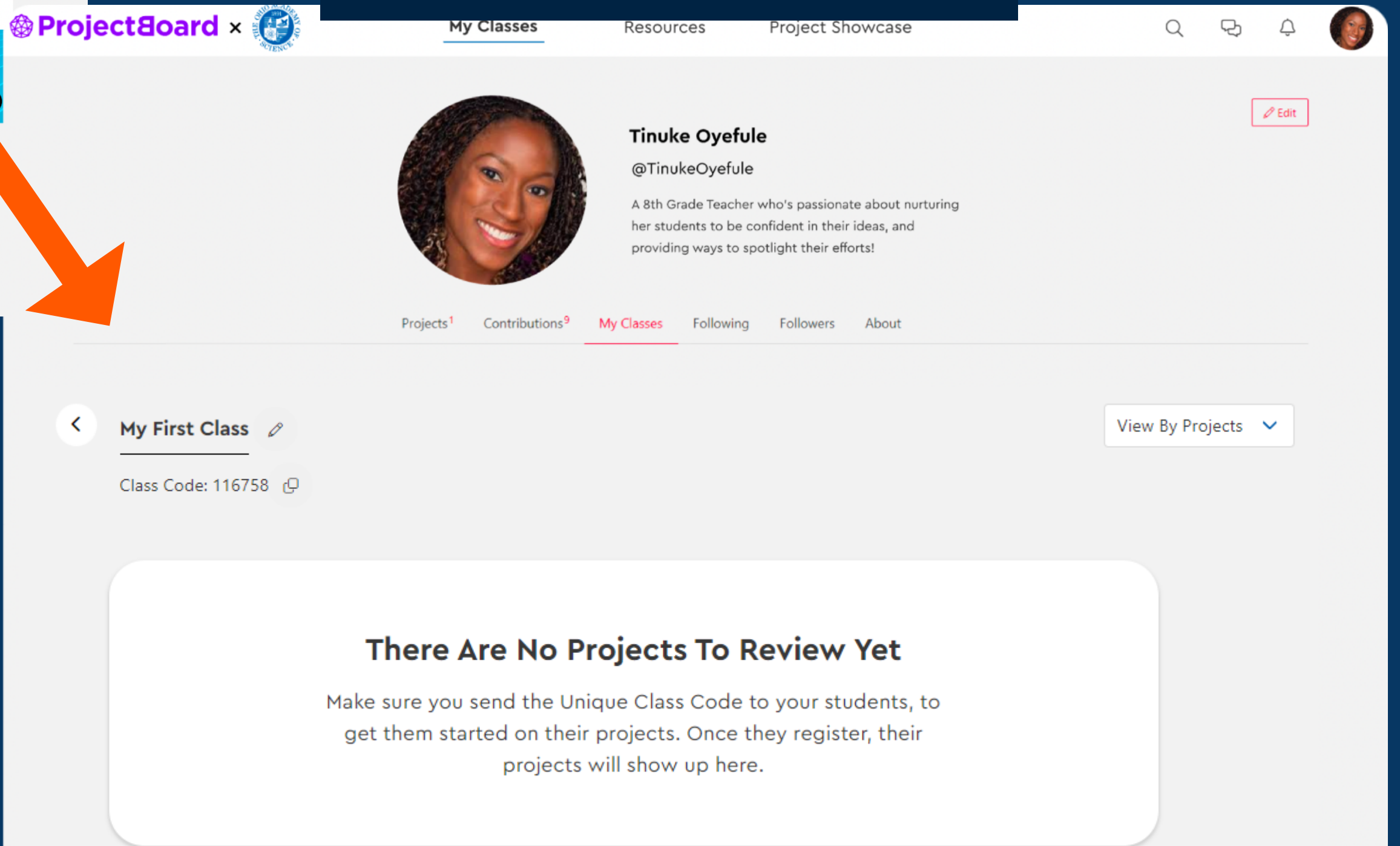

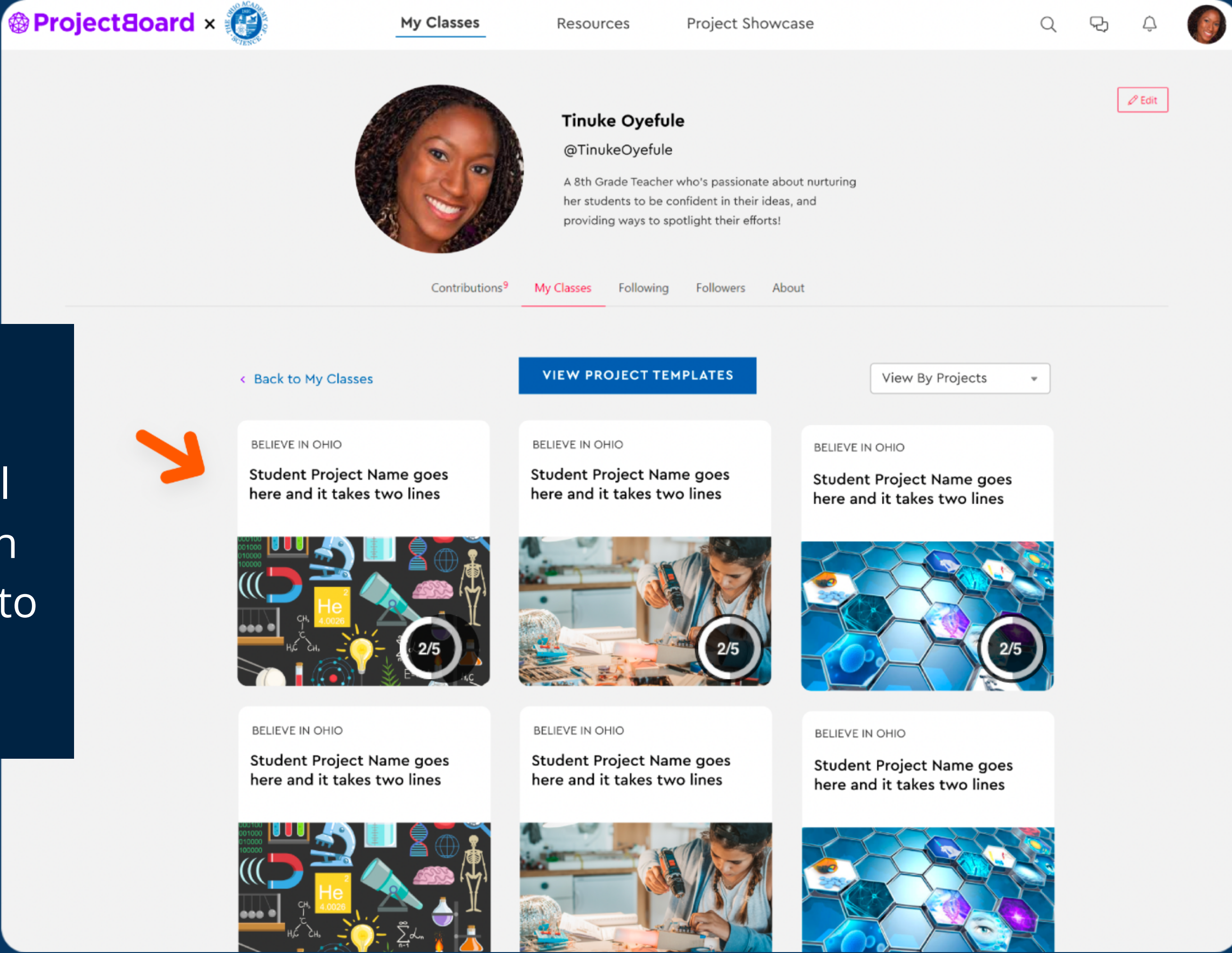


Clicking on a class

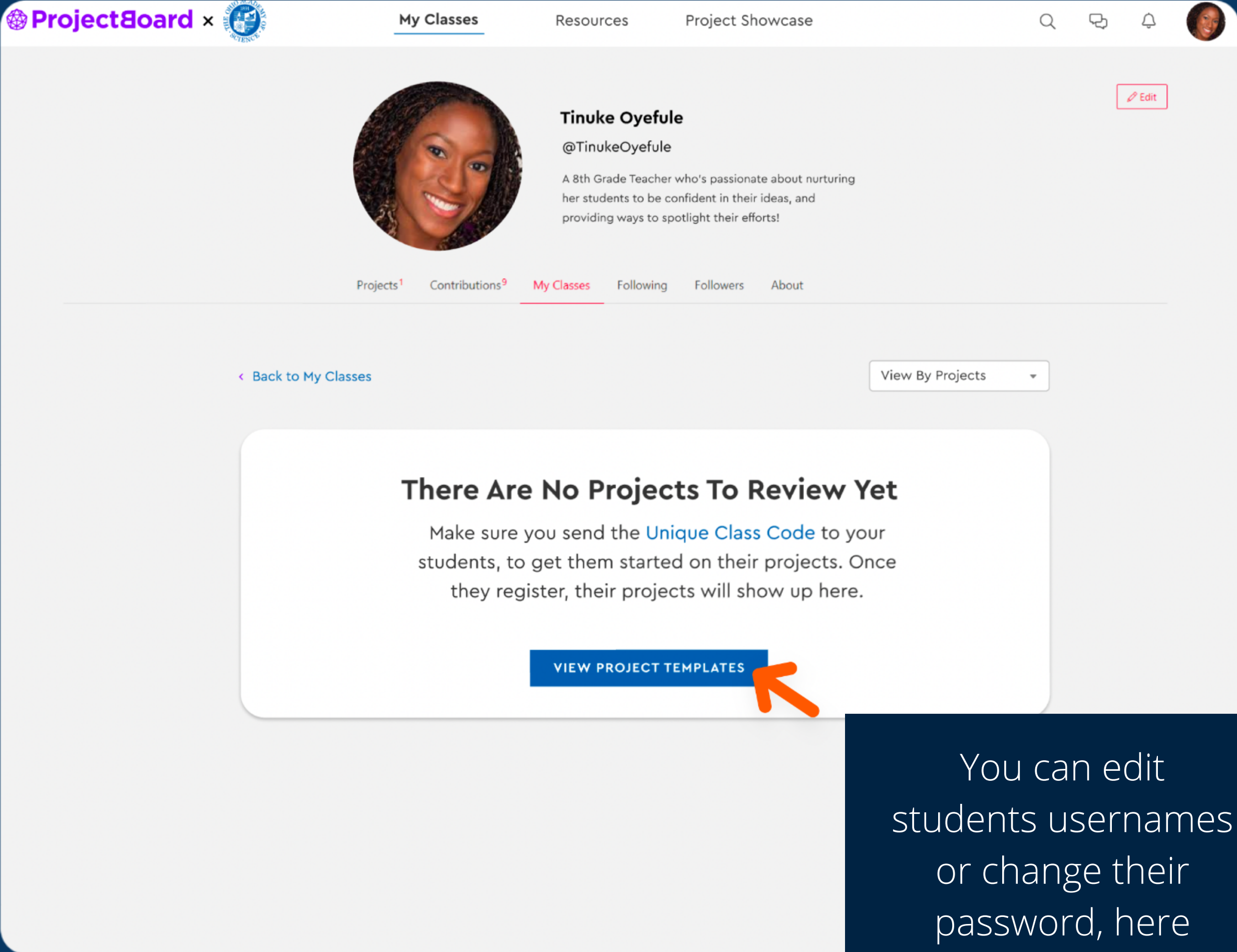
