NOTICE OF BENEFIT REQUIREMENTS

1. Student receiving VA Education Benefits should immediately report the last day of attendance to the University of Rio Grande Veterans Affairs Representative if they stop attending a course before the course is completed.
2. Enroll only in courses that are applicable to your degree program. You will be held liable for repayment of money to the VA for any course(s) in which you enroll that cannot be applied toward your degree program.
3. If there is any change in the enrollment status (i.e. drop/add class, drop enrollment etc.) you must notify the Rio Grande Veterans Affairs Representative immediately so your hours can be adjusted with the VA. You, the student, are responsible for all debts to the Department of Veterans Affairs that may result due to an increase or decrease in the number of hours you are taking.
4. These grades will impact your benefits:

N – No grade; no benefit eligibility

U – Unsatisfactory performance; benefits *may* be affected

I – Incomplete; course cannot be repeated with benefits until the “I” grade has been changed

To receive benefits, this form and the *VA Enrollment Form* must be filled out each semester. Your signature indicates: (1) your affirmation that the information on the VA Enrollment Form is true and correct; (2) that you agree to observe the requirements outlined on this Notice of Benefit Requirements; (3) you will bring a copy of your class schedule for each semester you intend to receive benefits to the Rio Grande Veterans Affairs Representative as long as you are eligible and within good academic standing with the University.

- If you the Department of Veterans Affairs or Department of Defense is paying for your tuition and does not cover 100% of your tuition and fees then you must pay the difference, only exception to this is if you are receiving any type of Financial Aid that may pay that difference for you.
- If you are Chapter 30, 1606 or Chapter 35. Your bill must be paid before you attend classes.
