GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

To be considered for the RCP program, you must

- Apply and be officially admitted to the University of Rio Grande by the application deadline.
- Be sure to submit your RCP application along with a copy of your final high school transcript (at least 7 semesters for 2020 graduating seniors) and college transcript(s) together in an envelope to Vicki Crabtree, Chair, School of Allied Health, by the application deadline of June 1, 2020. **Incomplete applications will not be considered for admission into the program.**
- Developmental courses (if needed) in English, writing, reading, and/or math must be completed prior to admission into the program.

• **Deadline for application is June 1, 2020** •

If all of your information **has not been received** by this date, you will not be considered for admission into the RCP program.

• GENERAL REQUIREMENTS •

- Meet all University of Rio Grande/Rio Grande Community College admission requirements and be officially admitted to the University by the application deadline, **June 1, 2020**.
- Submit the RCP application along with supporting documentation in an envelope to the Chair of the School of Allied Health, Vicki Crabtree, by the application deadline of **June 1, 2020**. Supporting documentation includes: high school transcript, college transcript(s), and copies of allied health degrees and/or certificates (if applicable).
- **SUPPLEMENTARY APPLICATIONS ARE ONLY GOOD FOR ONE YEAR. YOU MUST REAPPLY EACH YEAR. AFTER STUDENTS ARE CHOSEN FOR THE NEXT ACADEMIC YEAR, ALL APPLICATIONS WILL BE DISCARDED.**

• ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS •

One unit of high school **biology, algebra, and chemistry** or college-level equivalents - all with a minimum grade of C.

Students applying to RCP program are required to take an entrance exam. Information about the exam will be available after application deadline date.

Developmental courses (if needed) in English, writing, reading, and/or math must be completed prior to admission into the program.

High School GPA of 2.5 or College GPA of 2.5 (College GPA will be used if the applicant has attended at least one semester of college with at least 12 semester hours attempted.)

Current CPR certification (must be maintained throughout enrollment in program). Not needed in order to apply.

Successful completion of AHC 10101 – Intro. to Allied Health Professions (waived only for high school seniors entering the program upon high school graduation in 2020 and transfer students accepted into the program).

All applicants must have completed high school before admission into the program.

Students with GEDs must successfully complete 24 semester hours of college work with a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher. College courses must include any needed prereq courses listed above.
